Unfortunately, we are not able to allow non-members to participate this year.

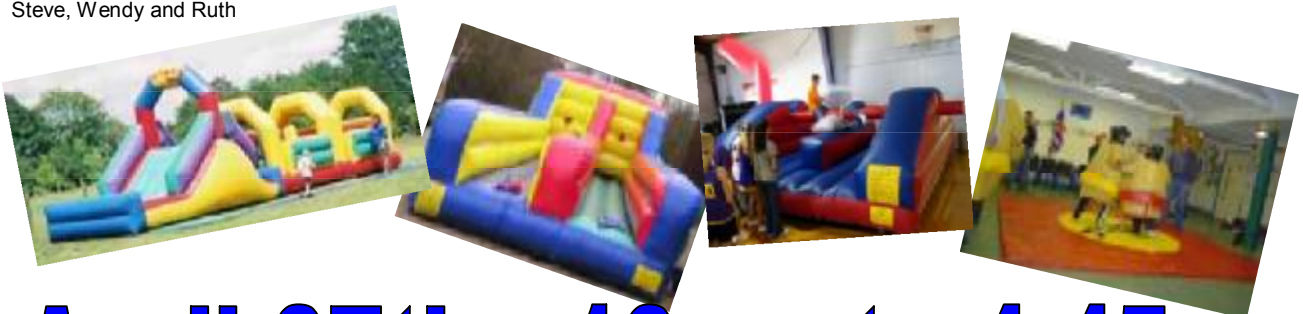
What to Wear
